Donors Tied to ERCOT Board Gave House Members More Than \$700,000

s the Texas House opens hearings on recent colossal failures of the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) overseeing the state electric grid, one question may be too impertinent to ask. Over the past two years, powerful energy interests with seats on ERCOT's board invested more than \$700,606 in the campaigns of the House members now investigating ERCOT—averaging \$4,671 per member. Would that money have been better spent protecting our energy grid from severe weather?

Just as foxes make the best henhouse guardians, ERCOT's board is populated by some of the energy interests that failed so spectacularly in the recent storm. The PAC and executives of the state's largest electric utility, Oncor, gave close to \$500,000 to current House members over the past two years, averaging \$3,205 per House member. The PAC of another big utility, American Electric Power, gave House members \$126,000.

ERCOT-tied donors gave \$83,000, or 12 percent of their House haul, to Speaker Dade Phelan, who has enormous influence over the hearings. The chairs of two committees heading up the ERCOT investigation also rank among the top recipients. Energy Resources Chair Craig Goldman landed \$13,800 from ERCOT-tied donors, while State Affairs Chair Chris Paddie received \$11,000. Members of those two committees received an average of \$6,804 in ERCOT contributions, well above the House average. Researchers did not find any ERCOT-tied contributions to 10 House members listed at the bottom of the table below.
